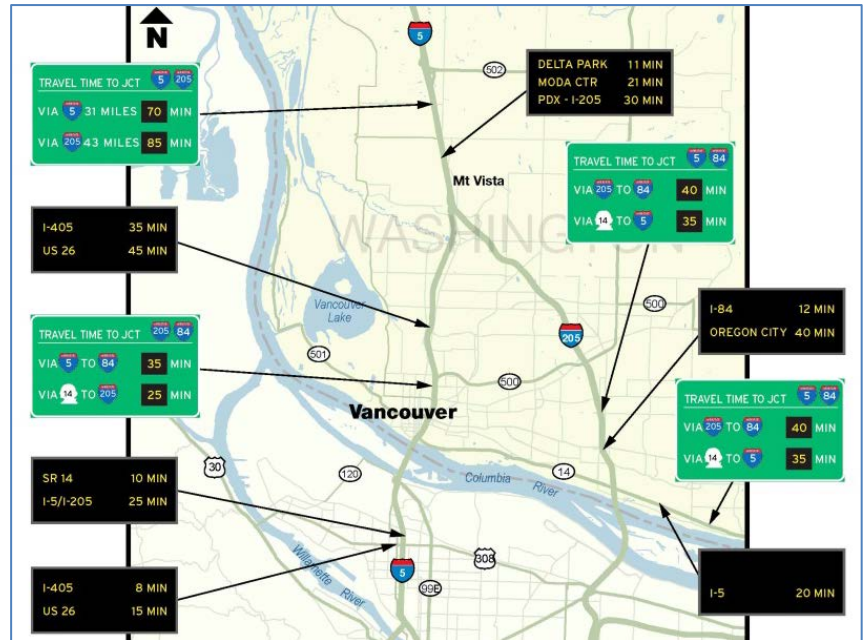

Project Description

The WSDOT Bi-state Travel Time project is a joint collaboration with ODOT. In the Vancouver region, it provides real-time travel information to the public along the I-5, I-205, and SR-14 corridors. The project consists of white on green guide signs showing travel times to specific destinations via alternate routes and variable message signs with travel times to destinations along a route.
