Project Description

The Project improves pedestrian safety across one of the City's busiest streets, by warning motorist when pedestrians and bicyclists are crossing 4th Street at Stonecreek Drive. Project also links the Brezee Creek trail.

The Project included LED pedestrian signs, crosswalk striping, truncated domes at an existing ramp, and an advanced warning LED pedestrian sign.
