Project Description

Purchased six 40-foot low-floor, hybrid buses to replace older buses that have all reached their useful lives. Research indicates that hybrid technology reduces particular matter emissions by as much as 75 percent, with an additional 25-52 percent reduction in fuel consumption to further reduce the agency's carbon footprint, while saving additional local funds spent on fuel.
